The Guild Scholar Scholarship Program for Visually Impaired (National)

Sponsor: The Jewish Guild for the Blind

Amount: 12-15 - \$15,000

Eligibility: **High School Juniors. With recipients selected and scholarships awarded later in their senior year.** Complete the online application. Proof of legal blindness. Proof of U.S. citizenship or legal residency. Documentation of academic achievement. Three letters of recommendation. Two personal statements: one about the applicant and the second describing the influence of an outstanding teacher on your education. Your chosen college must be accredited by a body recognized by the Council for Higher Education Accreditation.
